TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY*

1. Applications for entry must be on the appropriate entry forms available from section stewards or at sedgemoorvintageclubltd.co.uk and accompanied by the relevant insurance documents. Please enclose a stamped and addressed envelope (Minimum A5), to receive notification of acceptance and entry wrist bands.
2. All exhibitors must book in with their section steward before 10am on days attending.
3. The duration of the show is from 10am – 5pm on both days. Vehicles are prohibited from moving on site between 10am and 5pm, unless accompanied by a steward.
4. Vehicles are obliged to appear in their sections parade if applicable.
5. Exhibitor wrist bands must be worn at all times. Otherwise, admission fees will apply.
6. Strictly ONE person per Tractor exhibit. Maximum TWO (eg Driver and Steerer) per steam exhibit.
7. Stationary Engine Exhibits: No Awnings in display line.
8. All exhibits / exhibitors / traders, including exhibits with pressure boilers or vessels must be insured against third party risks on the entire show site (including camping and parking areas) and private approach roads. SVC will require proof of insurance (and annual boiler inspection certificate if applicable) All entries must be covered by a public liability policy (including rally use) with a limit of indemnity no less than £500,000.00 for any one incident.
9. In the case of an event taking place wholly or partly on the public highway, applicable entries must be covered by insurances required by the Road Traffic Act (1960).
10. Drivers of entries must hold a current valid UK driving licence, and not disqualified from holding or obtaining a licence to drive the applicable vehicle.

Full Terms and Conditions of entry to Sedgemoor Vintage Show 2026

1. Applications for entry must be on the appropriate entry forms available from section stewards or at sedgemoorvintageclubltd.co.uk and accompanied by the relevant insurance documents. Please enclose a stamped and addressed envelope (Minimum A5), to receive notification of acceptance and entry wrist bands.
2. All exhibitors must book in with their section steward before 10am on days attending.
3. The duration of the show is from 10am – 5pm on both days. Vehicles are prohibited from moving on site between 10am and 5pm, unless accompanied by a steward.
4. Vehicles are obliged to appear in their sections parade if applicable.
5. Exhibitor wrist bands must be always worn. Otherwise, admission fees will apply.
6. Strictly ONE person per Tractor exhibit. Maximum TWO (eg Driver and Steerer) per steam exhibit.
7. Stationary Engine Exhibits: No Awnings in display line.
8. All exhibits / exhibitors / traders, including exhibits with pressure boilers or vessels must be insured against third party risks on the entire show site (including camping and parking areas) and private approach roads. SVC will require proof of insurance (and annual boiler inspection certificate if applicable) All entries must be covered by a public liability policy (including rally use) with a limit of indemnity no less than £500,000.00 for any one incident.
9. In the case of any event taking place wholly or partly on the public highway, applicable entries must be covered by insurances as required by the Road Traffic Act (1960).
10. Drivers of entries must hold a current valid UK driving licence and not disqualified from holding or obtaining a licence to drive the vehicle.
11. The Sedgemoor Vintage Show is open to all forms of steam or motor driven transport, farm machinery (agricultural & horticultural), Stationary engines, vintage cycles, and associated services subject to eligibility.
12. Valid proof of insurance must be provided when requested. Updated policy information must be provided if insurance expires between date of entry and the show dates.
13. Exhibits must be presented complete, clean, and in safe working order.
14. All drivers and vehicles must meet the requirements and conditions of the Road Traffic acts and licencing authorities as appropriate (no underage drivers).
15. Code of Practice: SVC, exhibitors and members of the public are required to follow codes of practice in respect of fire precautions, health, hygiene, and safety etc. All persons must pay due regard to instructions from the stewards or SVC management and should always conduct themselves in a proper manner with no inconvenience to others.
16. All vehicles must be parked safely and securely, braked and or chocked. No exhibit to be left running unattended or in the charge of a person unable to stop or control it.
17. Static Exhibits with exposed moving parts must only be operated behind the barriers provided.
18. No item of any nature is to be offered for sale in any part of the site without prior written consent from SVC. Trade & Craft accepted.
19. Vehicle Clubs: Entries will be accepted from invited organisations. Each club should nominate one competent person to act on its behalf on all matters relating to the show. The display area allocated must not be exceeded. Clubs may display advertising material and regalia. Club entries will not be eligible for judging.
20. Entry to site: Each exhibitor will be provided with TWO wrist bands for their exhibit. Children under 16 do not require wrist bands. Extra bands may be collected on request from the relevant section steward.
21. All exhibits to be unloaded in the area provided. Site-wide speed limit of 5 MPH.
22. Right of admission reserved for all entries. Exhibits not correctly entered on the day, or breaking any rules will be asked to leave site.
